

COVID-19 WORSHIP COMMANDMENTS

Updated: March 20, 2022

- If you are sick, have a fever, are coughing, or have been in contact with someone diagnosed or showing symptoms of COVID – 19, please stay at home.
- If you are immuno-compromised be very careful. Consider watching the service at home on Facebook Live.
- Masking is optional for worship services. Outside of worship, all teams, groups and committees will determine their own comfortability with masking or not.
- Use hand sanitizer upon entry into the building. Please be aware of surfaces you touch.
- Bulletins and sanitizing supplies can be obtained at a special table set up in the narthex.
- Try not to sit directly behind other worshippers. Household groups are asked to stagger their seating.
- Offerings plates will not be passed around during the service; two offering plates will be available at each entrance to the sanctuary.
- Avoid physical contact with anyone you are not related to and living with.
- Worshippers are encouraged to limit their “Passing of the Peace” to those directly around them. You are encouraged to “Pass the Peace” through words or gestures without physical contact. As always, please keep any physical contact limited to those who are comfortable with such gestures.
- Wash your hands often.
